# Tahoe-Pyramid Bikeway, Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation Map 2 of 3: Hatchery To Nixon Store

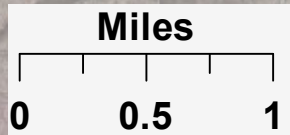
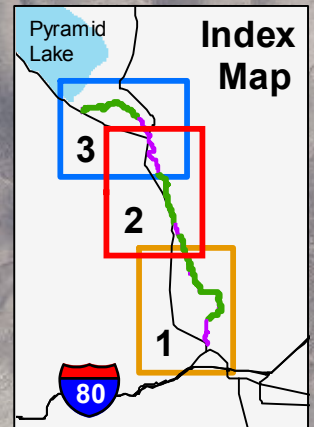
- **A Tribal Day-Use Permit must be displayed on your dashboard** during your time on the Reservation.
- Permits are available for purchase (\$7) at Tribal Stores in Wadsworth and Nixon, or at the Ranger Station in Sutcliffe.
- Please park in designated areas.
- No off-road travel; no ATV use by non-Tribal members.
- No horses on trail; no reckless bike riding.
- Do not disturb plants, animals, artifacts or residents.

**TRAIL USER ADVISORY**

- This trail segment is largely comprised of unpaved and low-traffic rural roads, requiring mountain bikes or touring bikes with off-pavement tires. Some sections are sandy.
- Experienced riders only.
- Watch for cars on the shared-road sections of trail.
- Watch for dogs in residential areas.
- Be self-sufficient. Carry repair kits, first-aid and water.
- The trail is not patrolled.
- Drinking water, phones and restrooms are available only at the Tribal stores in Nixon and Wadsworth.
- Cell phone coverage is marginal. Let friends know your schedule. In case of emergency, call 911.
