



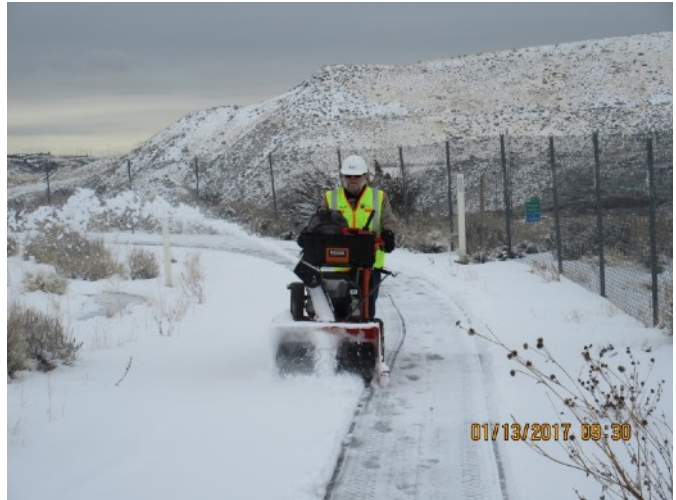

TRAIL CONDITIONS POST-FLOOD



- The trail east and west of Farad survived the flood very well, and is muddy but passable.
- The old road opposite Floriston is a mess and not passable. It isn't just the rocks (shown at left) but very deep sticky mud also.
- Fleish Road continues to be closed until March, per TMWA.
- The Nature Conservancy closed the trail from Mustang east, due to flooding.
- The Rez trail condition is unknown—probably a wash-out.

2017 CONSTRUCTION BIDDING

We plan to build another section of trail in the Truckee Canyon in 2017 and will be going out to bid in a formal competitive process in the spring. This section will be 1.2 miles of 4-foot wide earthen trail, mostly built on a steep cross-slope with retaining walls.
