Tahoe-Pyramid Bikeway gets \$200K in donations

The Tahoe-Pyramid Bikeway representatives received more than \$200,000 in private donations in 2014.

The funds went toward a vision of connecting Lake Tahoe to Pyramid Lake with a trail along the Truckee River.
